

# All-City Choir Information

## Description

The AISD All-City Choral Festival is an incredible event that features performances from **4th, 5th and 6th** grade choirs. The concert for this event is recorded and televised on the AISD channel about two months later. It is a wonderful performance opportunity where the students can experience what it's like to sing with a very large number of students, and perform in a professional setting in front of a sizeable audience.

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## Practice Recordings

Starting today: Download or listen to your voice part on the choir website, <http://kealingmschoirandmusic.weebly.com> If you aren't sure what voice part to learn, ask Ms. Parks. Go to the link "music files" and enter "singinhornets" as the password to access this webpage. **Students are expected to learn the music on their own, and come to the first rehearsal, on Oct. 10, with the music prepared.**

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## Requirements

**Application:** Students must turn in the application by **Tuesday, October 9**. Students may also turn the application in early. **I can only accept the first 12 applications.**

**Rehearsals:** Students must attend rehearsals from **3-4 PM on Wednesday, October 10 and Wednesday, October 17 at KMS**. Failure to attend these rehearsals, or showing up unprepared, will result in expulsion from the All-City Choir.

**Concert Day Timeline: Tuesday, Oct. 30 (A Day) AISD Performing Arts Center, 1500 Barbara Jordan Blvd.**

- 11:52 (Start of C Lunch) Students will meet Ms. Parks in the courtyard. Students who normally have A or B lunch will have already eaten. Students who normally have C or D lunch will have an opportunity to eat before boarding the bus.
- 12:30 Board bus
- 1:00 Arrive at Performing Arts Center. Rehearse
- 5:45 Pizza dinner break & activities
- 7:00 Concert Begins
- 8:00 Concert Ends

**Please keep in mind that our choir fundraiser, the Fall Festival, is on Friday, November 2 and is a REQUIRED event.**

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**Additional Information:** Students will be provided with a T-shirt, and need to wear blue jeans. Students parents' are expected to come to the concert and take their child home after the concert. Please let me know if transportation is an issue. **Only family members with a ticket will be permitted to enter the concert. Performers do not need a ticket to get into this event. Each family is guaranteed three tickets, but more may be requested if they are available. This information will be sent home with selected students after the audition.**
