- The audition will be held in the choir room on Wednesday, September 16 from 3:00 – 4:30 PM. **(The late bus leaves Kealing at 5pm. If your child needs to take the late bus, they can go to the Think Tank until that time.)**
- Each student MUST turn this form into Ms. Parks signed, on or before Wednesday, September 16 in order to be considered for A Cappella.
- **Students need to sign up for a 5 minute audition slot. During that time minute slot, they will sing some basic vocal warm-ups with Ms. Parks' leadership.**
- **At 3:45, all auditionees will come together for a group vocal audition, and a group movement audition. Ms. Parks will teach the movement routine, and then observe groups of students.**
- Ms. Parks will be looking for students with confidence, students who can sing out, students who match pitch, students who have basic dancing abilities, and students who do not have behavior issues at school or in choir class.
