Here is the information about our upcoming UIL Concert and Sight-reading Competition. UIL Concert and Sight-reading Competition: Friday, April 7.

This is a REQUIRED competition for all eligible Intermediate Choir students. The students have been working on three pieces which they will perform as a choir in front of three judges. The students have also been working on their sight-reading skills, which they will put to the test in the sight-reading room in front of a panel of three different judges. The students will be ranked on a scale of 1-5, 1 being the best.

Please make sure students WEAR their UIL Dress and shoes to school! Students will meet at the back of the school by the theater at 7:00 AM. I will have granola bars for all students. We will then take the bus to Austin ISD Performing Arts Center. The competition is as follows:
