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Region Contest is a wonderful opportunity for students to grow as independent musicians! Students learn four pieces of music on their own, with assistance from Ms. Parks. Two days before the competition, the Region committee announces which two pieces the students will audition with. Students will perform portions of these two pieces for a group of judges. The students who rank the highest, will be placed in the All Region Choir. All of the details are listed below. Please call or email me if you have any more questions! These dates were listed on the calendar given to you at the beginning of the school year, and have also been on the website since the start of the school year.

Grading Policy

- Advanced Girls' and Boys' Choir students are required to attend TMEA Region 18 MS Choir Contest as a test grade. All academically eligible choir students who fail to participate will receive a test grade zero, will be required to pay back the \$10 student fee, and will be required to complete an alternative assignment to make up this grade. Students with an invalid excuse will receive a 70 or less on the alternative makeup assignment. The alternative assignment will be due the following Friday to receive credit.
- ALL other eligible 7th/8th graders are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED to attend the TMEA Region 18 Choir Contest.
- Students are expected to practice the music, which can be found on the choir website, ON THEIR OWN. We will work some in class, but it will take home practice in order to adequately prepare for the competition. Students will also be able to practice in the choir room during lunch and 4th or 8th period, with permission from their teacher.
- **Please note that 7th grade students who are taking the SAT on the date of TMEA Region 18 MS Choir Contest will need to make arrangements for a 1:30 PM audition time by specifying this on the permission slip.**
- **Also note that 8th grade students taking the LASA exam need to take the exam on the alternate weekend it is offered.**

What to expect the day of TMEA Region Choir Contest:

1. Students should meet at the BACK of KMS NO LATER than 7:15 AM.
2. Students should wear their choir t-shirt, school dress code bottoms, and bring their music, snacks and water.

3. Once students arrive at Dripping Springs MS, they will need to find their name on the posters. Their name should be listed on the poster with their choir and voice part on it (example: 8th Treble, soprano). Students should sign in with their section, and receive a badge.
4. Ms. Parks is a judge at Region contest this year, and WILL NOT be available for students or parents verbally or by phone during the rest of auditions. Phone numbers of parent chaperones will be given out when we approach the Region audition. Students will know who their contact adult is.
5. Students must keep their badge on until they audition so they will know what their audition number is. Students will be called by their number—not by their name.
7. Early check in will end about 8:30 AM. Students will do warm ups and go through the audition cuts twice at that point. Students will NOT be allowed to sing out loud again until they actually audition. They will be disqualified if they do.
8. While waiting to audition, students will be disqualified if they have ANY electronic devices out for any reason. This is to ensure the contest is fair to ALL students, especially students who audition first. If students need to call their parent, they must do so in the designated student cell phone zone.
9. Students should listen for their badge number to be called during the day. When it is, they should follow the room monitor to the room where they will sing for the judges.
10. When it is their turn to sing, students will go into a room with five judges. The judges will be behind a partition and will not be able to see students while they sing.
11. Students will sing by themselves without any help from anyone, including the voice on the recording. However, students may use their sheet music. Students are only required to sing two short parts from two of the songs we have learned (about two minutes).
12. Generally, a bus is NOT offered for after Region, and parents are expected to pick their child up. However, since Region is so far away this year, I will be sending out a parent survey to decide if a bus should be provided. If transportation ends up not being provided, please let me know at least two weeks in advance if transportation is going to be an issue, and we WILL work something out. :)
14. Ms. Parks will call students who made the TMEA Region 18 MS Choir or who qualified for the District Choir (honorable mention) later that day. Girls who compete in the 7th Treble or 8th Treble Choirs must make the top 26 per voice part in order to qualify. This information can also be found on the region 18 website. Boys who compete in the TTB Choir must make the top 18 per voice part.
16. **Students who are selected will be required to perform in a clinic / concert on Saturday, February 9 from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM at the Austin ISD, PAC.**
